Guidelines for Resolving Issues

Pre-registration Process

Important Notice for G-TELP IBT at Home Test-Takers

- G-TELP IBT at Home records the examination process of the test takers. Please note that the following actions may be considered as misconduct.
- *As this test is conducted online, please ensure that you are taking the test in a location with a stable network connection.
 1. Ensure you have your ID card ready.
 2. Have your mobile phone on hand for the ID card registration and the facial recognition process.
 3. Complete the pre-registration at least 10 minutes before the test begins.
 4. You must register using your own ID and facial details. Registering someone else's information is strictly forbidden.
 5. Be aware that altering your appearance, such as adding or removing glasses, between pre-registration and the test is considered misconduct.
 6. Select your photo for the score report carefully, as it will appear in the final documentation.

Test Takers

- *G-TELP IBT at Home records the examination process of the test takers. Please note that the following actions may be considered as misconduct.
 - *As this test is conducted online, please ensure that you are taking the test in a location with a stable network connection.
1. During the test, engaging in conversations with others, using a phone (except for test monitoring purposes), or any form of communication with external parties is strictly prohibited. Only the registered test-taker is permitted to take the test, and it must be conducted in a private, independent space.
 2. Opening any programs, accessing operating system commands, using special keys, copying or capturing test questions, or attempting to record or leak test content—either internally or externally—through any means, including recording software, is strictly prohibited and considered acts of misconduct.
 3. Intentionally navigating away from the test browser, disrupting screen sharing, running unauthorized programs, or manipulating your computer or related equipment during the test is considered misconduct.
 4. The use of dual monitors or multiple monitors during the test is strictly prohibited and will be treated as an act of misconduct.
 5. Deliberate non-compliance with test procedures, such as covering the camera or altering the screen orientation, is considered a violation and an act of misconduct.
 6. Refusing to comply with the proctor's instructions or requests will be considered as misconduct.

3. Use the 'Retake' option to ensure the selected photo closely matches your face.

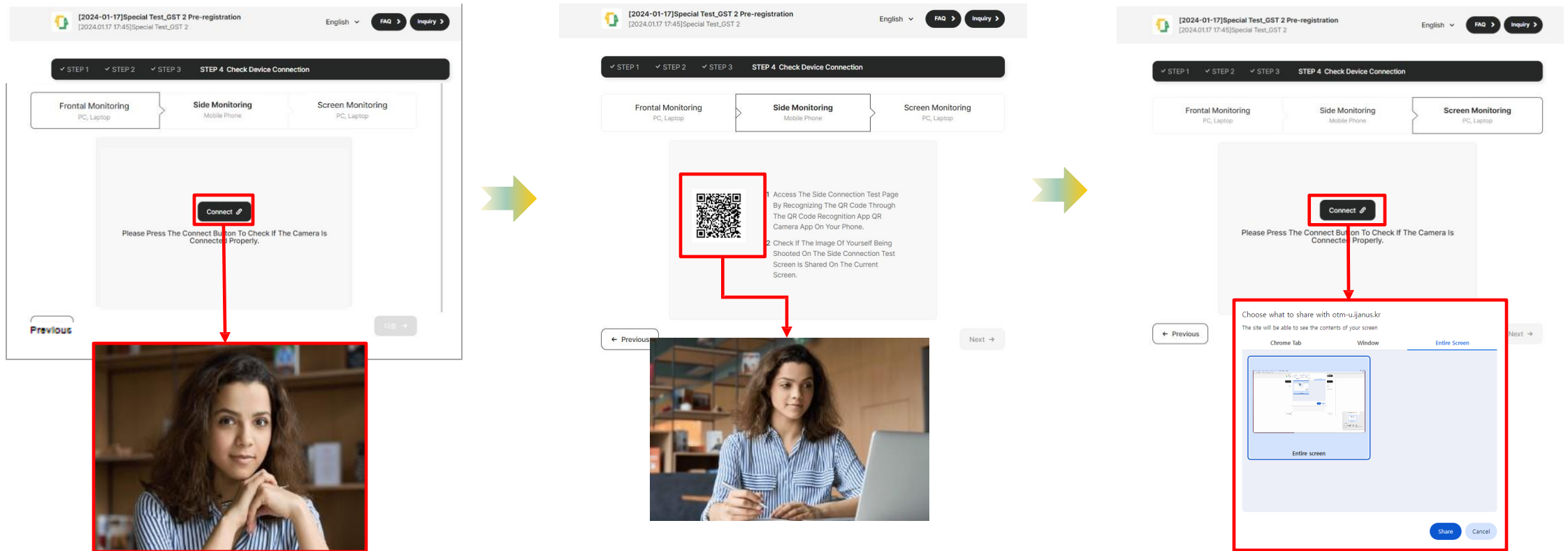

Connect the Side Monitoring Device (Mobile Phone)

1. Use the camera app on your mobile device to scan the QR code. Click the URL that appears to establish the side monitoring connection.
2. Place the mobile phone horizontally on a stable stand.
3. Adjust the phone's position to ensure it captures the bottom of the laptop and the surrounding testing area, verifying that no prohibited items are present.
4. Confirm the camera angle provides a clear and unobstructed view to monitor for prohibited items throughout the exam.



Policies and violations



Cheating Regulations

5. After checking the volume, click 'next' is above.
